

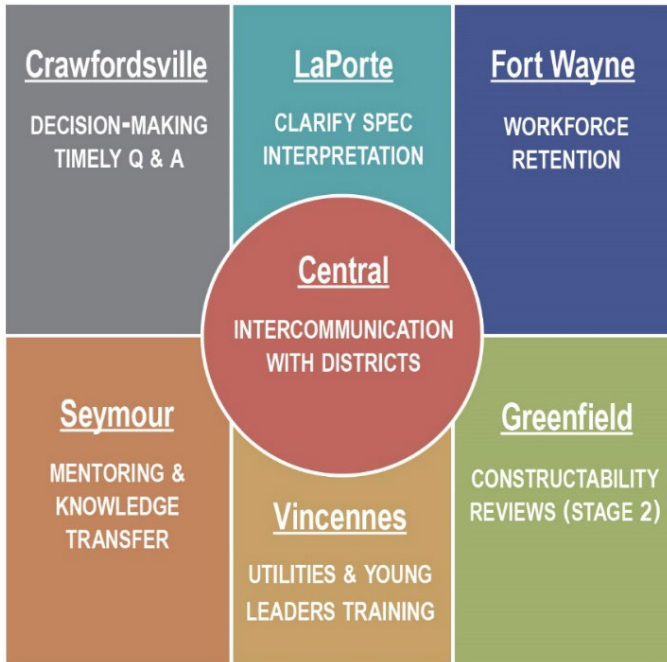

# 2022 ITT District Committee Initiatives

## Crawfordsville

### FORMALIZED DECISION RIGHTS

The Crawfordsville District ITT Committee goal was to “Formalize Decision Making Rights” with an initiative to develop a draft framework matrix for formalized decision making, which the district did and presented at the ITT meeting on January 18<sup>th</sup>.

## Greenfield

### PROGRESS MEETINGS

The Greenfield District has developed a Construction Progress Meeting Agenda Template to be used for conducting effective construction progress meetings. The template is intended to cover all major discussion items and do so in a consistent and comprehensive manner for clear documentation of project status, expectations, and upcoming action items.

## Fort Wayne

### FEEDBACK LOOP

The Fort Wayne District initiative for 2022 was to improve the feedback loop from design to construction and vice versa. The district presented a plan of action for shared progress and cross-training opportunities.



## LaPorte

### AFTER-ACTION REVIEW

In 2022, the LaPorte District ITT Committee focused its efforts on an After-Action Review Initiative. The goal of this endeavor was to facilitate a timely and organized after-construction review opportunity, in which all stakeholders could gather and have open dialogue regarding successes, challenges, and lessons learned. The LaPorte Committee’s efforts culminated in the form of an After-Action Review Meeting outline.

## Seymour

### CROSS TRAINING AND SOFT SKILLS

The Seymour District ITT Committee developed soft skills training called “Partnering, beyond the M&M’s.” The training provides a framework for partnering soft skills training that can be rolled out quarterly at progress meetings or viewed on-demand. At progress meetings, Area or Project Engineers can use this training to kick off the meeting and get everyone in a partnering mindset, view the video, and facilitate a brief discussion.

## Vincennes

### PRE-CON

The Vincennes District goal was to standardize the pre-construction meeting process and establish norms for hybrid meetings. To assist in this process, the district committee created workable documents outlining expectations for both initiatives.
